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In today's fast-evolving global business environment, organizations must continuously strengthen their frameworks in governance, risk management and compliance (GRC) — while simultaneously advancing sustainability to create resilient, future-proof organisations. The International Benchmarking and Master Class in China titled “**Advancing GRC and Sustainability**” offers a strategic platform for senior practitioners and decision-makers to observe, analyse and adopt cutting-edge practices in a market that is rapidly becoming a global standard-setter.

China has accelerated its institutional reforms and sustainability agenda in recent years. For example, its national ESG disclosure rules are being harmonised under a unified standard to be implemented by 2030. Meanwhile, the country's enterprise governance, risk and compliance market is expected to grow from USD 3.16 billion in 2023 to more than USD 8.25 billion by 2030—at a CAGR of 14.7%. These indicators illustrate both the scale of the opportunity and the imperative for organisations to stay ahead.

Participants in this program will engage with pioneering Chinese organisations, gain exposure to real-world governance and sustainability innovations, and benchmark against one of the world's most dynamic regulatory and business ecosystems. The insights acquired will empower them to elevate their own GRC and sustainability frameworks—enhancing transparency, strengthening stakeholder trust and unlocking long-term value creation.
